Principal's Report

- Happy New Year
- Tightening up protocols - Masks are encouraged to upgrade to surgical or N95 (Staff is required to wear N95)
 - Continuing to do seating assignments at lunch and in class
 - Children are playing in classroom zones again
 - Early morning drop off is 7:35. At 7:45 kids can go in their classrooms
 - Covid flowchart from the district has helpful information
- Drive-thru test kit will be available soon, more info to follow
- Health Clerk - Rahel addressed Covid quarantine rules/questions
 - Modified quarantine - students who are close contact but were wearing a mask at all times can do modified quarantine
 - Full quarantine - close contact with covid positive person w/ no mask (Lunch for example)
 - If the student is vaccinated - they can continue to come to school w/ a negative test on day 1 and day 5
 - Email Rahel your vaccination cards - rrezaeinia@lvusd.org
 - Any test is accepted - even home test
 - If your student is in direct contact with Covid positive person and they are vaccinated - monitor for symptoms and they can still come to school and test them on the 5th day from exposure.
- LVUSD Dashboard shows positive cases
- You should get an email notification when there is a case in your class
- Question - when a child comes to the nurse's office with sore throat etc - do they get sent home or sent back to class to monitor? Rahel - parents are notified and the child is picked up
- Question - how is educational support? Teachers are putting together packets. LVIS Virtual school is an option. Work directly with your child's teacher to determine what is the best option for your child

- Question - how is attendance marked if you are at home quarantining? As long as work is done it is considered an “independent study” and not counted as an absence. Families need to sign an independent study contract. If no work is returned then they will be marked absent.
- Question - if teachers are sick do they get to take off? Yes, sub coverage has been hard to come by but they are planning ahead as best as they can.

Treasurer's Report

- Nicole - 196K raised in YES Fund
 - Fall Auction 8K Raised
 - Some money come in from community partners, hoping to have Spring Fundraisers to help out
 - Paying the district in installments for PE
 - District has changed the timeline for the budget commit for Fall 2022 - decision to be made in the next few weeks. We may have to make cuts if we don't raise more money.
 - All elementary schools received a grant toward visual and performing arts. Coach Baker is funded by PFA. District pays for 3 campus aides/supervisors, we have 6 and would like to add more but we need funds.
